



NORTH-EASI

NATHULA PASS

Nathula, one of the highest motorable roads in the world, is a mountain pass in the Himalayan peaks that co-joins Sikkim and China. Situated on the Indo-Tibetan border 14450 ft. above sea level, it is one of the most important Himalayan passes in the country.

MG ROAD

MG Road is the heart of Gangtok. It is the central shopping hub with various shops, restaurants, and hotels lined up along both sides. MG Road is an open mall or boulevard square which is widely regarded to be the town centre and is the best shopping destination for tourists.

BABA MANDIR


Baba Mandir is a holy shrine situated at the distance of 50 km from Gangtok towards Nathula Border between China and India.

GHOOM MONASTERY



RIMBI WATER FALLS


MUST VISITS: SIKKIM

RUMTEK MONASTERY

The Rumtek Monastery is one of the largest and most significant monasteries in Sikkim, perched on top of a hill 23 km from Gangtok. Originally called as the Dharma Chakra Centre, it belongs to the Kargyu sect of Buddhists who originated in Tibet in the 12th century.

TSOMGO LAKE

Tsomgo Lake is a glacial lake that derives its water from the melting snows of the mountains around it. This glacial lake is famous for its colour changing waters. Monsoons see a bright aquamarine lake whereas, in the winters, it freezes into a translucent cover of ice. As the summer approaches in mid-May, the periphery of this lake is dotted with a thousand blossoming flowers that lend the waters a riot of vibrant colours.








LACHEN, LACHUNG & YUMTHANG VALLEY


